**Lamborghini  
Trescone 2004**

**\$14.99** per bottle **or \$161.89** per case

In the 1970s, Ferruccio Lamborghini bought this estate and began producing wine with winemaker Riccardo Cotarella. It has been a beacon of high-quality wine production in Umbria for decades now. The Trescone is a blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and a small amount of Montepulciano. It is broad and rich and a big wine that is begging for you to share it with friends alongside some grilled steaks!

We've carried the "regular" Waterbrook Chardonnay for quite some time now, but a recent taste of the **Reserve Chardonnay** proved fruitful for our **Wine of the Month Program**! This Washington State winery makes great use of the cool-climate Chardonnay. It is rich with fruit and has a good balance. They also hit the wine with some new oak to give it a buttery richness that makes it a joy for bigger foods.

**Rosé 2008**
